Potential to collaborate with other provinces. Current Constitution states Jan 15-March 6th is the timeframe for Nationals (minimum of 12 weeks before a world championship)
- i. Youth divisions discussion on doping control for youth and the nature around what is involved with conducting the tests. If a parent refuses to allow a CCES representative to conduct the test, they are sanctioned. The point of youth division is to grow the sport; CPU level requires some refinement and SPA needs to take some of these forward to the CPU board.
