1. The purpose of this policy is to ensure coaches understand their responsibility to create a sporting environment free of harassment, abuse, bullying, and neglect. The association requires all coaches representing the SPA to complete the online Respect in Sport (RiS) certification. There are no other equivalences for this course.
2. The certification course is located at this link: <https://sasksrc.respectgroupinc.com/>
3. The policy applies to all coaches registered or named as an official SPA coach.
4. Coaches must complete the RiS certification training prior to coaching Team Saskatchewan at any event.
5. The association is responsible for ensuring coaches are aware of and complete the RiS certification training.
6. Any coach not having completed the RiS certification training by the deadline established will be removed as a coach until such time that the course is completed.
7. Non-compliance with this policy may result in further discipline as determined by the Board of Directors or in accordance with the Discipline and Complaints Policy.
8. The President of the association will have administrative access to the RiS database to oversee functions such as report generation and monitoring.
